### Learning of the Week

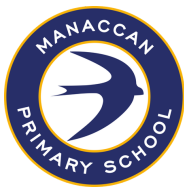

Do you enjoy taking photos? You can enter up to three photos for each of these titles, just make sure your photos are no larger than 7 x 5 inches!

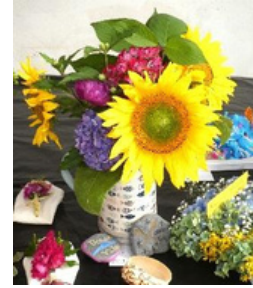
